

Vintage Kids: Elementary Musical Worship Leader

Goal(s):

- To encourage & nurture knowledge of the Bible, a worshipful spirit, and relationship with Jesus
- To be an example of an adult who loves & follows Jesus (so that kids see that following Jesus is the real deal, it's not only something that their parents do)
- To serve not only the kids, but their whole family

What gifts/talents/skills are needed in this part of Vintage Kids ministry?

- A love for elementary children
- Skill in a specific instrument: voice, guitar, drums, keys, dance, etc.
- The ability and willingness to communicate Biblical truths in elementary appropriate ways
- Classroom management skills
- Flexibility- being able to monitor how things are going and adjust the activities accordingly
- Ability to receive constructive feedback about worship styles
- Work well with a team

What are the individual responsibilities of the member?

- Develop a 10 to 15 minute worship set that is high energy, captivating, interactive, and kid-friendly based on the weekly curriculum provided by the Kids Director
- Consistently pray for the kids you work with and their families
- Attend our prayer huddle before class starts to lift up the morning to the Lord as an entire team
- Be intentional about getting to know kids, their families & other Vintage Kids volunteers
- Follow schedule provided by Kids Director
- Participate and encourage participation in Large Group worship, skits, and lesson
- Communicate to the Director of Kids Ministry any new ideas, encouraging stories, and feedback on how to improve the ministry

Time Investment: 1.5 hr/week once a month

- Serve once a month at either the 9am and/or 11am gathering
- Arrive 30 minutes before gathering begins
- To be well prepared for Sunday, you'll need to choose & communicate songs to Kids Director and rehearse songs at home or schedule time to rehearse in the building, (30 min - 1 hour)
- Attend team meetings for encouragement, brainstorming and training (6 meetings a year)
