- Missionary Letter writing: Throughout the year writing letters to our missionaries and the children we support around the world.
- Prayer: Spend time praying for our missionaries, children's home and world events.
- Special projects: Projects that come up once in a while for our missionary partners and children's homes.

Opportunities Global: 4-10 days

- Mission trips: Going on a VFC mission trip to another country. Serving others by doing building projects, children's ministry, outreach and getting to know and share Jesus with the people in the community. (We are not sure how this will look this upcoming year with COVID, but are hopeful that a trip will come together soon.)
