### Personal Responsibilities:

- Seek to grow in relationship with Jesus through the spiritual practices of prayer, worship, and scripture reading.
- Live out the VFC principles of being a Worshiping Community of Missional Theologians.

### Ministry Responsibilities:

- Approach every artistic opportunity looking to glorify God above all else.
- Be informed and skillful in the required skill sets needed to curate sacred spaces.
- Be knowledgeable of the history of sacred spaces and prayer stations in relation to ministry and the teachings of Jesus; apply this in a creative context.
- Collaborate with the Sacred Space Team Leader and the Director of Creative Arts to integrate your artistic vision into a Sunday gathering or special event.
- Respond promptly to any email, phone, or text communications.
- Show up promptly to any installations, Sunday Gatherings or special events that you will be serving at.
- Be open to discussing your work or passion with folks outside of the sacred space team.
- Research or develop new material or ideas to present to the Sacred Space Team Leader and the Director of Creative Arts.
- Attend and participate in all-Palette team and vision nights.
