- Collaborate with the Fine Arts Team Leader and the Director of Creative Arts to integrate your artistic vision into a Sunday gathering or special event.
- Respond promptly to any email, phone, or text communications.
- Show up promptly to any installations, Sunday Gatherings or special events that you will be serving at.
- Be open to discussing your work or passion with folks outside of the fine arts team.
- Research or develop new material or ideas to present to the Fine Arts Team Leader and the Director of Creative Arts.
- Attend and participate in all-Palette team and vision nights.
